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Lesson plan

Express Yourself with Interjections

Objective:

Students will learn to identify and use interjections to express emotions in English speaking and writing.

Materials:

- · Whiteboard and markers
- Worksheets

Lesson Plan:

- 1. **Introduction** (10 minutes)
 - Interjections are words that express emotions or feelings.

Examples: "Wow!", Ouch!, Hooray! and "Oh no!".

2. **Identification** (15 minutes)

 Show flashcards with various interjections and ask students to identify the emotions they represent.

3. **Practice** (20 minutes)

- Give students sentences missing interjections. Have them fill in with appropriate interjections.
- Practice using interjections in everyday conversations.

4. **Application** (15 minutes)

- Students write a short story using interjections to convey emotions.

5. Review and Summary (10 minutes)

- Recap the lesson highlights and discuss how interjections enhance language expression.
- Assign worksheets for additional practice at home.
